Re: Tritium Exit Sign Inventory – Demand for Information

Dear Ms. McIntosh:

American Multi-Cinema, Inc., d/b/a AMC Theatres (“AMC”) received a Demand for Information, dated January 16, 2009, with respect to tritium EXIT signs. AMC’s investigation and fact-finding is currently ongoing, and I am writing to request additional time within which to respond to the Demand.

To date, AMC has received partial historical purchase data from its supplier, Isolite. Isolite also received and disposed of signs on behalf of AMC as signs were replaced. AMC continues to work with Isolite on validating order information and expired or damaged sign return data. Isolite has indicated to AMC that this information will be finalized and available within the next three weeks.

In addition, AMC has undertaken site surveys to inventory tritium signs at its 310 theatre locations. AMC has completed 240 of these site surveys, and remaining surveys should be completed within the next three weeks. We anticipate needing to conduct follow-up surveys at some of these locations to validate results.

Once final survey data is complete, and Isolite purchase history is complete, AMC will be able to more fully respond to the Demand for Investigation. At this time, we anticipate completing the inventory by June 1, 2009. Therefore, we would ask for an extension to respond to the Demand for Investigation until and including June 15, 2009.
