SUBJECT

Control No. 317900- Re request by letter dated February 2, 2009, to delete a former gauge storage location (37867 Interchange Drive, Farmington Hills, Michigan) and replace it with nearby new one (37871 Interchange Drive, Farmington Hills, Michigan) for License No. 21-23314-01.

SUMMARY

In a telephone conversation with Mr. Gottschall on this date, I related that we can not authorize the release of an authorized use/storage facility for unrestricted use and remove it from the license as such, until we receive confirmation that all licensed material has been removed from the facility and that the facility meets NRC criteria for release for unrestricted use. In that regard, the following additional information would need to be provided:

1. Please confirm that all gauges formerly stored at 37867 Interchange Drive, Farmington Hills, Michigan, have been transferred to other of your facility locations.
2. Please provide the date(s) of transfer of each gauge and a copy of a leak test record, current as of the date of transfer, which confirms the non-leaking status of the source(s) in each gauge transferred.
3. Please confirm that no leaking sealed sources were ever stored/used at 37867 Interchange Drive, Farmington Hills, Michigan, based on routine leak test data.
4. Please confirm that no gauges/licensed material remain at 37867 Interchange Drive, Farmington Hills, Michigan.
5. I noted that NRC policy now requires that a total possession limit be placed on the license for each radionuclide authorized on the license. Please provide this information for both Cs-137 and Am-241.
6. In the referenced letter, you also requested to adopt the more recent version of NUREG-1556 Vol. 1, Rev. 1 issued in November 2001. In order to accomplish this, please refer to Appendix B (Suggested Format for Providing Information Requested in Items 5 through 11) of the Rev. 1 document and provide updated information for Items 7 through 11 only for our review and evaluation.
7. I also noted that License Condition 19 will be updated to address the required minimum of two independent physical controls to secure portable gauges from unauthorized removal whenever a gauge is not under the control and constant surveillance of the licensee.
