Gentlemen:

This refers to the visit of AEC personnel to your plant on December 22, 1960, to review the high Beta exposure readings received to bi-weekly film badges worn by one of your employees during the period of October 24 to November 14, 1960.

It was noted during the visit that Mr. David Neuman was not issued personnel monitoring equipment during the periods between September 31, 1960 and October 23, 1960 when he worked in the PRDC Control area, a restricted area, where he was likely to receive a radiation exposure in excess of 25% of the limits specified in 10 CFR 20, Appendix A. This was in violation of Section 20.202(a), "Personnel monitoring."

This deficiency was brought to your attention by the AEC representative and Mr. Metz stated that immediate steps would be taken to have film badges issued to all persons who enter the Control Area.

Please note the citation listed above is made under 10 CFR 20 prior to its revision on January 1, 1961. Enclosed is a copy of the former 10 CFR 20 under which you were inspected and a copy of the amended Part 20 which is currently effective.

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Personnel monitoring practices and records will be reviewed during the next inspection of your facilities.

There were no other items of noncompliance noted as a result of this visit. Your cooperation with us is appreciated.
