
The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) is considering the renewal of Special Nuclear Material License No. SNM-21 for the continued operation of the Energy Systems Group facility at Simi Hills, Ventura County, California.

The Commission's Division of Fuel Cycle and Material Safety has prepared an Environmental Assessment related to the renewal of Special Nuclear Material License No SNM-21. On the basis of this assessment, the Commission has concluded that the environmental impact created by the proposed license renewal action would not be significant and does not warrant the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement. Accordingly, it has been determined that a Finding of No Significant Impact is appropriate. The Environmental Assessment (NUREG-1077) is available for public inspection and copying at the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.
