**Retraction of Report of Discharge to Waters of The State**

Dear Sir/Madam:

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-6.10 Noncompliance Reporting, PSEG Nuclear LLC (PSEG) is submitting this report to retract the notification of a discharge of gasoline to the Delaware River from a vehicle fueling operation.

The discharge was reported to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) hotline at 14:35 hours on March 6, 2009 and assigned case number 090306150517 by Operator #34. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission was notified under event number 3018165151. This discharge was also reported to the National Response Center.

On March 6, 2009 at approximately 1435 hours, while filling the Fire Department's Command Vehicle with gasoline, there was a spray of gasoline from the fill connection toward the operator as the gas nozzle shut off and was removed from the vehicle. This resulted in approximately 2 to 3 ounces of gasoline to spill onto the ground. The ground was wet from melting snow and water running toward a storm drain about 15' away.

Due to the proximity of the storm drain to the leak, the Shift Manager notified the State due to the 15 minute notification requirement. Upon investigation, there was no discharge to the environment, and therefore, this notification is retracted.
