Dear Mr. O'Connor: this is to inform you that your request for an extension to respond to NRC's Demand for Information (DFI) regarding the tritium exit sign inventory has been granted. The new due date for response is July 17, 2009 as you requested.

While the new due date for your response to the inventory is July 17, in accordance with one of the requirements in Item A of the DFI, **NRC is still requiring that you respond by the due date of March 17, 2009,** with the name of the individual you have appointed for ensuring day to day compliance with the requirements to properly manage tritium exit signs.

Furthermore, please note that this extension does not relieve you of the regulatory requirement to report any lost, stolen, or missing signs you may discover as a result of your inventory efforts. Please refer to the DFI cover letter for instructions on reporting lost, stolen or missing signs.
