In accordance with 10 CFR 50.4(b)(5)(iii), 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Section V, and NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2004-15, Supplement 1, "Emergency Preparedness Issues: Post-9/11," dated May 25, 2006, Carolina Power & Light Company, now doing business as Progress Energy Carolinas, Inc., is submitting revisions to Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Unit Nos. 1 and 2, Abnormal Operating Procedure 0AOP-40.0, "Security Events."
