SUBJECT: NRC Inspection Findings

Dear Sir:

PharmaLogic has reviewed the inspection findings and offers the following in response to the recent U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission inspection of NRC RAM License Number 44-30124-01MD conducted on March 4, 2009.

Violation A: Pharmacist was found to have not conducted a survey of extremities upon exiting the restricted area and upon examination extremities; were found to have an area of radioactive contamination.

PharmaLogic recognizes this deficiency and has identified this incident as an isolated incident. PharmaLogic has conducted radiation safety training with the involved individual to include a review of Title 10 CFR Part 20. All employees at this licensed facility were instructed and actions evaluated as to the proper monitoring procedure when exiting a restricted area. Decontamination procedures were included in the facility-wide radiation safety training. Evaluation by the radiation safety officer will continue to ensure compliance with personnel monitoring over the next 90 days. Personnel training has been completed at this time.

Violation B: Licensee did not know the total exposure received by a pharmacist who worked at two licensed facilities during the period of January to March 2009.

This individual who worked at both facilities was monitored by an established radiation monitoring service during identified period. Exposure summary information for the time periods spent at both facilities was not available on-site during the inspection. PharmaLogic proposes that quarterly summaries will be compiled for any individual working at multiple licensed facilities. The facility Radiation Safety Officer will be responsible for compiling and maintaining this exposure profile. Documentation will be maintained at each facility involved. PharmaLogic management has instructed the professional staff that responsibility for maintaining their exposure history is inherent in proper personal radiation safety. Documentation will be completed by May 2009.
