Dear Ms. Miller:

Thank you for your letter of April 3, 2009, acknowledging your receipt of the Chapter 11 reorganization notifications submitted by Smurfit-Stone Container Enterprises, Inc.'s Virginia Pulp and Paper mills. We share your concern about ensuring that that the public health and safety are fully protected and that all of our devices containing radioactive materials are properly maintained and controlled. We also understand that our licenses remain in full effect while we proceed through the Chapter 11 reorganization.

We have not transferred any radioactive sources or their licenses as part of, or due to, the proceeding and have no **current** plans to do so. All of our licensed devices are sealed source units that are used to monitor production processes at our mills. All of our mills are continuing to operate normally and are properly maintaining and using these devices.

We have communicated the information in the agency's letter to our Law Department and bankruptcy counsel. SSCE is the only entity involved in the bankruptcy that owns/operates facilities that have radioactive materials licenses.
