The purpose of this letter is to respond to the request for additional information (RAI) identified in the NRC e-mail correspondence to UniStar Nuclear Energy, dated February 17, 2009 (Reference 1). This RAI addresses the Reliability Assurance Program (RAP), as discussed in Section 17.4 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 4.

Reference 1 requested UniStar Nuclear Energy to respond to this RAI within 30 days. In the UniStar Nuclear Energy letter dated March 19, 2009 (Reference 2) it was stated that a response to RAI 61, Questions 17.04-1 and 17.04-2 would be provided by April 30, 2009. UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize the response to Questions 17.04-1 and 17.04-2. A response to these questions will be provided to the NRC by May 29, 2009.

There are no regulatory commitments identified in this letter.


