The purpose of this letter is to respond to a request for additional information (RAI) identified in NRC e-mail correspondence to UniStar Nuclear Energy, dated February 24, 2009 (Reference 1). This RAI addresses Piping Systems and Components - Inspections, Tests, Analyses, and Acceptance Criteria as discussed in Section 14.2 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 4. Reference 1 requested UniStar to respond to the RAI within 30 days.

UniStar requires additional time to complete the response to RAI Question 14.03.03-1. A response to this question will be provided to the NRC by May 15, 2009.
