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
Dear License reviewer:

Dr. Stephen Fedec, DO,FACC has received 10 years , 3 months clinical training in Nuclear Cardiology at Ocean Heart Imaging from January 1 , 1999, to April 1,2009, under my tutelage. During this time he performed and interpreted more than 2,500 Nuclear Cardiology cases, including Stress and rest **Thallium**,and Stress and Rest Sestamibi myocardial **perfusion** imaging studies. More than 10 percent of these cases had **angiographic** correlation. He also received training in First Pass **Angiography**, Gated SPECT Imaging and **Pharmacological** Stress Testing with **Dipyridamole** and Adenosine along with Rest Gated Blood Pool imaging. He completed the 200 hours of didactic training that is required through Health Physics Services , Inc.

In total, he has received 4,000 hours of clinical training, including his didactic training. Dr. Fedec has successfully completed the 700 hours of clinical work experience and clinical interpretation required under NRC part 35.290, at Deborah Heart and Lung center, in Browns Mills NJ from 1993-1996, under the direction of Dr's. Elizabeth Paczolt and Frank **Lumia**, during his Cardiology Fellowship.

Dr. Fedec has achieved a level of competence sufficient to function independently as an authorized user for the medical uses authorized under NRC subpart E-imaging and localization.
