Response Date Extension to Open Items

Reference: Letter, Vanessa E. Quinn to Scott Head “Federal Emergency Management Agency’s (FEMA) Open Items (OIs) for the South Texas Project (STP) Units 3 & 4 Combined License (COL) Application,” dated April 1, 2009.

This letter documents Open Items (OIs) issued by the Reference which require an extension. A reason for the extension and the date by which the response is expected to be submitted is indicated below.

As stated in the referenced letter FEMA is requesting the completion of OIs within a 30 business-day period. Additional time is required to respond to these OIs. The State of Texas, Department of State Health Services (DSHS) is currently involved in a series of drills and exercises related to Radiological Dispersal Devices (RDD) which should conclude in late May, 2009. The DSHS is also affected by the Texas State Legislature being in session. The Assistant Commissioner-Texas Department of Health Services, Division for Regulatory Services is supporting the Legislature efforts. The Assistant Commissioner is the final approval authority for the State Plans and procedures related to radiological events.

In addition to the above, DSHS is required to gain concurrence of the Plan and procedure changes from external effected stakeholder agencies both at the county and State. The time required to gain these concurrences is crucial to assure a quality product is produced and implemented.

STP is requesting, for the State of Texas, a submittal date extension of June 30, 2009. In addition, STP is requesting to defer the Matagorda County OIs to ensure responses are submitted consistently within a single response.
