By letter dated June 12, 2008 and revised submittal dated August 22, 2008, AREVA NP, Inc. (AREVA) submitted an application to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to amend Materials License No. SNM-1227 pursuant to the requirements in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Section 70.72(d)(1). While preparing the safety evaluation report to support the review of this license amendment application, the NRC staff identified several topics requiring clarification. These topics were discussed during a conference call on April 1, 2009. However, a number of issues still need to be clarified by AREVA. Enclosed is a document containing the NRC staff's request for additional information (RAI) regarding the topics that were either not addressed or insufficiently addressed in the license amendment application. Your full and complete responses to the RAIs are necessary for the staff to complete its safety review. In order to meet our schedule, the additional information specified in the enclosure should be provided within 30 days from the date you receive this letter. Please be aware that if your responses to the RAIs contain proprietary information, you should mark your response letter accordingly.
