Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, Babst, Calland, Clements & Zomnir, P.C. hereby requests the following information:

Copies of any and all documents and correspondence relating to the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health's ("NIOSH") decision to evaluate United Nuclear Corporation's ("UNC") former employees' petition (the "Petition") requesting that all site employees at UNC's Hematite, Missouri nuclear fuel plant from January 1, 1958 through December 31, 1969 and January 1, 1970 through July 31, 2006 be designated a class (the "Class") to be included, pursuant to 42 C.F.R § 83, in the Special Exposure Cohort ("SEC") under the Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7384 *et seq.*

This request includes, but is not limited to, information regarding the factors the NIOHS considered in deciding to evaluate the Petition and the criteria for determining whether employees of a nuclear facility are eligible for inclusion in the SEC.


