SUBJECT: Summary of Teleconference with Applicant Held on April 28, 2009

On April 28, 2009, NRC staff (J. Nakoski, R. McIntyre, G. Wunder, S. Joseph, M. Snodderly, D. Taneja and J. Zhao) participated in a telephone conference call with STP Nuclear Operating Company (NOC) representatives (S. Head, B. Mookhoek, J. Tomkins et al) and representatives from Toshiba America Nuclear Energy (TANE) regarding the staff's upcoming inspection of Toshiba to support staff verification that Toshiba is qualified, as an Alternate Vendor, to supply the certified ABWR design.

The staff briefly discussed the technical areas on which the inspection would focus, including overall design Quality Assurance, Containment, Digital Instrumentation and Control, and the Initial Plant Test Program. The NRC Inspection Team decided on an inspection time frame of July 13-17 2009 at the Toshiba facility in Japan.

The staff requested that STP and/or TANE identify the scope of work that is performed at each Toshiba facility so that the staff will know where to focus their efforts and can arrange the appropriate travel plans. STP requested that follow-up break-out teleconferences or meetings, on each subject area, be held to allow for STP and Toshiba to adequately prepare for the inspection.

It was determined that the inspection would be performed under Part 52 and that the notification letter and inspection report (with findings, if any) would be issued to STP.

The main points-of-contact for NRC staff and STP/Toshiba will be Stacy Joseph (NRC) and Caroline Schlasseman (TANE) and all future correspondence regarding the Alternate Vendor Inspection should funnel through those individuals.
