By application dated June 3, 2008, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) requested the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approval of a construction authorization.

NRC staff has reviewed the information provided in your submittal and determined that additional information is required in order to complete its review. Questions in the enclosed request for additional information (RAI) were emailed on April 23, 2009, and discussed in a telephone call with Mr. Syed Bokhari, et al., of your staff on May 4, 2009. Based on the clarification questions discussed during the call, NRC is making two editorial/clarification changes to questions # 2 and # 9 enclosed with this RAI. The due date for DOE responses is June 3, 2009, to this RAI (Set 6) for the Safety Evaluation Report Volume 2, Chapter 2.1.1.7, Design of Structures, Systems and Components Important to Safety and Safety Controls.
