MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Supplement to Extension Motion)

On May 4, 2009, petitioners Missouri Coalition for the Environment and Missourians for Safe Energy (MCE/MSE) filed a motion for extension of time to submit their reply to the May 1, 2009 answers of applicant AmerenUE (AUE) and the NRC staff to the April 6, 2009 MCE/MSE hearing petition. It does not appear that the MCE/MSE pleading addresses the requirement in 10 C.F.R. § 2.323(b) that for any motion, a movant "include a certification . . . [that states] that the movant has made a sincere effort to contact other parties in the proceeding and resolve the issue(s) raised in the motion, and that the movant's efforts to resolve the issue(s) have been unsuccessful."

Petitioners MCE/MSE shall have up to and including noon Eastern Time (ET) on Wednesday, May 6, 2009, to submit a pleading that conforms to this provision of the agency's rules. If MCE/MSE are unable to obtain consent from the other participants to their extension

request, any participant wishing to file an answer to MCE/MSE's May 4 time extension request shall do so on or before <u>noon ET on Thursday</u>, <u>May 7, 2009</u>.¹

It is so ORDERED.
