PRE-LICENSING VISIT SUMMARY:

1. **Business Operations**

Three cardiologists are merging operations under the Hawaii Cardiology, LLC name. They intend to centralize their operations and billing practices. Wendell Pang is the owner and oversees the business side of operations. The three physicians will share the authorized medical physicist and nuclear medicine technologists. Reviewed Radiation Facility License granted by State of Hawaii Department of Health. The location and intended use match the request on their NRC license application.

2. Facility

> They are leasing part of the 3rd floor of St Francis hospital. The site matches the drawing in the application. They have a hot lab, camera room, and two treadmill rooms already constructed with equipment in place. Security is adequate at the hot lab keys are controlled by trained personnel.

3. **Radiation Safety Operations**

> Applicant will only perform heart scans. Pacific Radiopharmacy will provide 4 unit doses/day of Tc-99m as needed. Posting is adequate. Applicant will have a 4 uCi Cs-137 check source for calibration purposes. Ludlum survey instruments are calibrated and available. Applicant will provide dosimetry to radiation workers. Gamma Corp will perform audits. Safety procedures are adequate for scope of operations.

4. Personnel

> The AMP, AU's, and RSO have all been on NRC licenses but the owner was unknown, therefore, the NRC performed a pre-licensing visit. The AMP/AU was familiar with NRC requirements and the RSO was able to assist with any issues.
