Dear Mr. DeLaBarre:

Enclosed is an application, dated April 8, 2009, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) from Curtiss-Wright Electro-Mechanical Corporation requesting Amendment No. 01 to export license XR172 for nuclear equipment exports to the People's Republic of China. The purpose of this amendment is to add: 1) one ultimate consignee (subsidiary company); 2) two intermediate consignees (subsidiary companies); and 3) six intermediate consignees (independent).

We have prepared the enclosed list (Enclosure 2) summarizing the additions that the applicant is requesting to their existing license and indicating which involve subsidiary companies and which involve non-related subcontractors and/or subsidiaries.

Since no other changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license are requested, we are processing this as a minor amendment. As discussed separately, please advise once you have communicated the proposed additions to the Chinese Government authorities. At that

point and after the required 30-day waiting period has elapsed, the NRC intends to issue this minor amendment when it is determined that applicable export license criteria are met.
