PURPOSE:

The discussion will include some advance planning of future NRC audits of the piping systems and components design.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES:

There should be agreement on the direction of the review of the piping systems and components portion of the US-APWR design review. This will include identification of the need and timing of future audits as well as the likely documents MHI will need to make available to be audited in the U.S.
