Introduction

Following is the information for the Fermi 3 reading rooms being established for us by DTE Energy (DTE). The list of documents to be provided in the reading rooms, on which you had a chance to comment, is attached. These are documents that either DTE will not provide to us at all or will not provide to us soon. DTE is targeting Monday, March 23, 2009 to have the reading rooms set up, but that is not firm; however, I will let you know as soon as the opening date is confirmed.

There will be three reading rooms, located near NRC/ERI, Argonne, and Ecology and Environment (E&E). All three will be at DTE facilities. The current plan is to keep the facilities open for a period of 30 calendar days from the opening date; but if you will need more time, please let me know in advance of the closing date. You are all strongly encouraged to access these reading rooms ASAP, to help in developing RAIs and preliminary draft EIS sections.

Ground Rules

The procedure for use of the reading rooms would be that you would call the site contact and give at least 24 hours notice of who is coming to the facility, their names, and how long they plan to stay. Upon arrival, you will check in with the contact person, sign in, and be provided with a DVD containing the documents. (Note: As indicated in the attached list, not all of the documents will be available at all of the reading rooms.) There will be computer terminals for your use at each facility; however, please take note of the number of terminals available at each facility when making your plans for groups of staff to attend. You cannot use your own computers, there will be no hardcopies, no copying of the information on jump drives or disks will be allowed, and you cannot take anything with you from the facilities except for what you bring in and your notes. At the end of the stay, you will sign out and return the DVD.

We will have to be flexible with schedules at these locations. There may be a day or afternoon that will not work for them so we'll have to work around those things.
