This letter and the enclosed NRC Form 591M refer to the safety inspection conducted on April 23, 2009, at your facility in Broussard, Louisiana. The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the General License provisions contained in 10 CFR 150.20 as they relate to safety and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with conditions of the license.

Additionally, the inspector reviewed the licensee's corrective actions in response to the Confirmatory Order (EA-06-281 and EA-07-289) issued to Accurate NDE and Inspection, LLC dated February 20, 2008. The Order was issued as a result of a successful alternative dispute resolution (ADR) mediation conducted in November 2007. Based on the review, the NRC verified that the licensee had complied with all commitments described in the Order in a timely manner. A final exit briefing was conducted with your Radiation Safety Officer on April 28, 2009.

Within the scope of this inspection no violations or deviations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC Form 591M is required.
