Carla,

I would like to invite you, other FDEP staff, and other Florida government offices with an interest to attend the site audit of Progress Energy's Levy County combined license (COL) application.

As background information, the purpose of the site audit includes the following:

- Provide the NRC staff and NRC contractor reviewers with the opportunity to gain first-hand general familiarity of the affected environment.
- Meet with the applicant and the application preparers to discuss information requests that the NRC staff and NRC contractors have after having reviewed the combined license application.
- View, observe, and document the affected resources within each technical discipline in the site and vicinity.
- Consult with affected stakeholders such as other Federal, State, and local agencies, and capture their findings from the site audit.

The site audit is scheduled for the week of December 1, 2008, with the meeting location at the Crystal River Nuclear Training Center located at 8200 W Venable St., Crystal River, Florida. We are developing the site audit schedule and expect that that FDEP staff may wish to attend the first day, December 2nd. This is typically when we would have a meeting with the State government representatives and provide overviews of the application, issues of general interest, and the opportunity for a site tour.

In order to set up the necessary logistics, I do ask if you could let me know by November 21, 2008, who the Florida staff are that will be attending the site audit. Please cc Andrew Kugler and Jessie Muir on any reply.
