In Reference (a), the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) transmitted one licensee-identified finding that has preliminarily been determined to be White, a finding with low to moderate safety significance, which may require additional NRC inspection. The finding is associated with inadequate implementation of the preventive maintenance (PM) program for the turbine-driven auxiliary feedwater (TDAFW) pump governor that led to a failure of the pump to operate properly.
