Dear Ms. Edwards: this is to inform you that your request for a 60-day extension sent via a letter dated March 12, 2009, has been granted. The new due date for response is May 16, 2009, which is 60 days from the original due date of March 17, 2009.

Please note that while the new due date for response to NRC's Demand for Information (regarding the tritium exit sign inventory) is May 16, this extension does not relieve you of the regulatory requirement to report any lost, stolen, or missing signs you may discover as a result of your inventory efforts.
