The purpose of this letter is to inform you of a change in the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). Please amend the name of the RSO from Dominick Scaramuzzino, Ph.D. to Thomas Soriano. There is no change in the responsibilities of the RSO, management, facility location and/or operations.

**Training and Experience of Mr. Soriano**

Mr. Soriano, President and Chief Executive Officer of DOCRO, Inc., has over 25 years of laboratory experience working with radioactive materials most recently at DOCRO, Inc. and DIANON Systems, Inc., as well as other companies and at Cornell University, Ithaca, New York. He has extensively worked with radioisotopes such as <sup>32</sup>P, I<sup>125</sup>, and <sup>3</sup>H., for the research, development, validation, and performance of a wide variety of biological and clinical laboratory tests.

Mr. Soriano was trained initially at Cornell University in 1983 by Dr. Andre Bensadoun, Professor and Director of Division of Nutritional Sciences. At the time, Dr. Bensadoun was the lone faculty member of Cornell's Radiation Safety Committee. From 1983 - 1984 Mr. Soriano was the RSO and trainer for one of the largest research groups at Cornell University.
