(Summary of May 20, 2009 Telephonic Status Conference)

On Wednesday, May 20, 2009, the Board held a status conference in this proceeding via telephone. Participating in the conference were Kimberly Sexton and Catherine Marco from the NRC Office of General Counsel; Cynthia Carpenter and Nicholas Hilton from the NRC Office of Enforcement; and Billie Garde, counsel for Andrew Siemaszko.

During the conference, the parties indicated that productive settlement discussions have occurred, and they believe they are progressing toward a settlement agreement that can be presented to the Board in the near future. Based on that representation, the Board stated it would allow the parties to continue settlement discussions for an additional 30 days before scheduling another status conference. If a settlement or an impasse is reached within this 30-day timeframe, the parties shall notify the Board's law clerk so a status conference may be scheduled at an earlier date.

The Board also inquired regarding the status of Mr. Siemaszko's appeal to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit. The Board was informed that the Sixth Circuit has set a briefing schedule, and Mr. Siemaszko's opening brief is due on June 10, 2009.

If counsel for either Mr. Siemaszko or the NRC Staff believe this Summary of May 20, 2009 Status Conference is incorrect, they shall file a Motion to Correct the Record no later than May 28, 2009.
