SUBJECT: SUBMITTAL TO INCIDENT REPORTING SYSTEM VIA WEB-BASED  
SYSTEM

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission submits relevant reactor-related generic communications to the international community through the internet via the Web-Based Incident Reporting System (WBIRS). The reports are coded using the Incident Reporting System Reporting Guidelines manual, and the full documents are submitted.
