This concerns your letter dated February 27, 2009, informing the Commission of your medical use of naturally occurring and accelerator-produced radioactive material (NARM).

Since the medical use of unsealed NARM is now covered under 10 CFR 35.200 and the medical use of sealed NARM calibration/reference sources is authorized under 10 CFR 35.65, you are currently in compliance with NRC requirements, therefore, an amendment to your NRC license is not required.
