This letter and the enclosed NRC Form 591M refer to the initial safety inspection conducted on April 21, 2009 at your facility in Houma, Louisiana. The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the authority of Byproduct Materials License 17-29308-01 as they relate to safety and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with conditions of the license.

Additionally, the inspection reviewed the licensee's corrective actions in response to the Confirmatory Order (EA-08-008, EA-08-009, EA-08-010, and EA-08-011) issued to Global X-Ray & Testing Corporation (GXT) dated May 23, 2008. The Order was issued as a result of a successful alternative dispute resolution (ADR) mediation conducted in April 2008. Based on the review, the NRC verified that the licensee had complied with all commitments described in the Order in a timely manner. A final exit briefing was conducted with you on April 28, 2009.

Within the scope of this inspection no violations or deviations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC Form 591M is required.



