Dear Mr. Barnett:

This is in reference to your email attachment dated April 21, 2009 which supplied additional information regarding your request to renew Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 39-32137-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

In your email attachment, you do not provide sufficient information regarding the gauge which had been stored at 340 Garfield Street, Kingsford, Michigan. Your current license authorizes use at temporary job sites but, does not have any permanent locations of storage or use. In your email attachment regarding the gauge previously stored at 340 Garfield Street, Kingsford, Michigan, you state "the unit has been relocated to a location in Wisconsin". Verify that the gauge has been transferred to a valid licensee authorized to possess the radioactive materials. Specify the name of the licensee recipient and the recipient's NRC or Agreement State license number. For example, your gauge which had been located at 4475 Pounce Tract Road, Glen Allen, Virginia is now possessed under Commonwealth of Virginia license number 39-32137-04.

Current NRC regulations and guidance are included on the NRC's website at www.nrc.gov; select **Nuclear Materials; Medical, Academic, and Industrial Uses of Nuclear Material**; then **Regulations, Guidance, and Communications**. You may also obtain these documents by contacting the Government Printing Office (GPO) toll-free at 1-866-512-1800. The GPO is open from 7:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. EST, Monday through Friday (except Federal holidays).

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region I Office and refer to Mail Control No. 143217. If you have any technical questions regarding this deficiency letter, please call Steve Hammann at (610) 337-5399.

In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter.
