This telephone conversation record summarizes communications by e-mail.

For St. Mary's Medical Center, Jim stated that the licensee does not wish to add Pd-103 brachytherapy sources as part of the current amendment.

For Cabell Huntington Hospital, Jim confirmed that shielding in the PET/CT suite was constructed according to the recommendations in the report provided earlier [see ML091410030]. He said: "The shielding of the PET/CT department appears to be as specified Facilities management physically measured the ceiling concrete thickness to be 8.5". PET/CT personnel dosimetry badge readings have not been excessive with no ALARA Level I or II's."
