QUESTION from Balance of Plant Branch 1 (SBPA)

Levy COL Application FSAR section 9.2.8 TCS, Piping, states the following: "System piping is made of carbon steel. Piping and connections are welded, except where flange connections are used for accessibility and maintenance of components. Nonmetallic piping may be used in accordance with ASME B31.1 and as demonstrated by evaluation."

ASME B31.1 Appendix III states that nonmetallic piping is limited to 140 F and 150 PSI in water service application.

Please, provide information on whether the use of nonmetallic piping will be within these limits.
