SUBJECT: REVISION 1 OF THE FINAL STANDARD REVIEW PLAN FOR THE
REVIEW OF REMEDIAL ACTION OF INACTIVE MILL TAILINGS SITES
UNDER TITLE I OF THE URANIUM MILL TAILINGS RADIATION
CONTROL ACT

At its 53rd meeting, May 19-20, 1993, the Advisory Committee on Nuclear Waste met with the NRC staff to discuss the subject document. The Committee concluded that the revised Standard Review Plan was well prepared, covered the subject in a comprehensive and clear manner, and therefore is ready to be issued.

The Committee recognizes that there are differences in the regulatory considerations associated with Title I and Title II sites. Nonetheless, we believe that the general approach outlined in the subject document will also be suitable for application to Title II sites.
