UNRESTRICTED RELEASE OF NEWSTEAD AVENUE FACILITY FROM
PHARMACIA LICENSE

Pharmacia Corporation, the licensee, provided a license amendment request with enclosed Newstead Avenue Site Decommissioning Final Status Report (ML090920862) to the NRC on April 1, 2009 to request unrestricted release of the site. On May 21, 2009, the licensee was contacted by the NRC to discuss the following questions raised by the review.

1. What was the approximate timeframe for when licensed activities stopped at the facility?

Licensee Response: Licensed research activities ceased on March 16, 2009.

2. What is the justification for classifying the east and west office areas of the second floor as non-impacted areas.

Licensee Response: The areas are and according to the historical site assessment, have always been office places. They are located physically separate from laboratory areas. Offices commingled with research areas were classified as impacted class 3.

The licensee was informed that the NRC intends to conduct a confirmatory site survey on June 4, 2009. The licensee agreed to this date.
