Dear Dr. Hardy:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 31, amending your NRC Material License No. 24-01381-01 in accordance with your request by letter dated March 2, 2009, and by facsimile received May 14, 2009. This amendment involves acknowledgement of a Change of Control of St. Alexius Hospital Corporation #1 dba St. Alexius Hospital from Envision Hospital Corporation to Success Healthcare 2, LLC. This Change of Control resulted from the purchase on December 10, 2008, by Success Healthcare 2, LLC, of 100% of the stock of St. Alexius Hospital Corporation #1 dba St. Alexius Hospital. The transfer did not result in a change in the name of the hospital nor any other changes involving the license program. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
