Dear Mr. Guenther and Mr. Silverstein,

This is in reference to Mr. Guenther's letter dated May 20, 2009 and Mr. Silverstein's letter dated May 26, 2009, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 29-30707-01 and application for new License No. 31-31364-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office and refer to Mail Control No. 143748 and 143628. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.

1. Mr. Guenther, you have requested for a transfer of a specific area from License No. 29-30707-01 to License No. 31-31364-01. Prior to the transfer of licensed activities to another licensee, 10 CFR 30.35(g), 30.36(k)(4) and 30.51 require that you transfer certain records to a successor licensee to ensure their long-term availability. Confirm that you have transferred, or will transfer, the following records; if records are not applicable, explain why.

- a. for unsealed materials with half-lives greater than 120 days, records for disposal made pursuant to 10 CFR 20.2002 (alternate disposal procedures, including burial authorized prior to January 28, 1981), 20.2003 (disposals to the sanitary sewerage system), 20.2004 (incineration of wastes), 20.2005 (disposal of specific wastes including liquid scintillation cocktail and animal tissue), and 20.2103(b)(4), evaluations of effluent releases.
- b. records important for decommissioning as described in 30.35(g). Examples of such records include but are not limited to: records of contamination, identifying the radionuclides, quantities and concentrations; as-built drawings and modifications of structures and equipment in restricted areas and locations of inaccessible contamination such as buried pipes; a single list, updated at least every 2 years, of areas to which access is limited for the purpose of radiation protection (restricted areas); and records related to the provision of financial assurance.

Transfers will not be authorized unless all required records have been transferred to the person continuing the licensed activity, or you have confirmed the records to be transferred and which records are not applicable to your program. Describe the method and proposed timetable for transfer of required records.

2. Memory Pharmaceutical corporation has requested the transfer of laboratory 143 to Psychogenics Inc. Based on the application from Psychogenics Inc., they do not plan to use this location for the use of materials. Mr. Silverstein, please confirm your acceptance of this laboratory to be incorporated into your licensing basis in which your company will be responsible for eventual decommissioning and release or Mr. Guenther, please withdraw

Memory Pharmaceuticals Corporation's request to transfer laboratory 143 to Psychogenics Inc. and decommission this laboratory as part of the rest of your facility.

3. Mr. Guenther, according to our records, you are not the management contact for Memory Pharmaceuticals Corporation. Please have Ms. Joanne Leonard confirm your amendment request dated May 20, 2009.

Please note that you may not reply to this letter by return e-mail. Your reply must be in writing by letter or facsimile (610-337-5269). If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
