This refers to the inspection conducted on May 22, 2009, at a temporary job site on Tinker Air Force Base in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the general license of 10 CFR 150.20 as it relates to safety and security, and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of the license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records and interviews with personnel. Preliminary inspection findings were discussed with your staff at the conclusion of the onsite portion of the inspection. A final exit briefing was conducted with you on May 27, 2009.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations or deviations of NRC requirements were identified; therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC Form 591M is required.
