Dear Sir:

AmerenUE submits this response to the referenced NRC letter concerning the NRC's conditions for use of an online reference portal during the review of the Combined License (COL) application for AmerenUE – Callaway Plant Unit 2. AmerenUE had previously proposed the use of an online reference portal (electronic reading room). The referenced letter accepts the use of an online portal and provides a list of conditions to be maintained throughout the duration of the Callaway Plant Unit 2 COL application review process. AmerenUE was asked to confirm that these conditions will be maintained.

AmerenUE hereby confirms that the conditions listed in the referenced letter will be maintained throughout the duration of the Callaway Plant Unit 2 COL application review process. A description of some of the key elements of the AmerenUE electronic reading room are as follows:

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NRO

The electronic reading room is password-protected, and passwords will be distributed to staff directly involved in the COL application review on a need-to-know basis;

The electronic reading room disables any printing, saving or downloading functions to any location other than a printer or server controlled by AmerenUE (note – AmerenUE cannot prevent a user from printing a single page via screen print or from taking a picture of a computer screen with a camera);

Staff given password access to the electronic reading room will be informed of the conditions of use of the electronic reading room via an acknowledgment message presented upon entry;

AmerenUE understands that staff given password access to the electronic reading room will be informed of the conditions of use by the NRC project managers.

As noted above, AmerenUE agrees to the conditions contained in the referenced NRC letter and will maintain these conditions throughout the COL application review for as long as the electronic reading room is available to NRC reviewers.
