

The purpose of this modification is to 1) exercise option year 1 thereby increasing the contract ceiling in Sections B.5 and B.6, 2) extend the period of performance from June 23, 2009 to June 23, 2010 and 3) change the NRC Project Officer from Russell Anderson to Douglas Tharp. Accordingly the contract is modified as follows:

1) Refer to section B.5, entitled "CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION--DELIVERY ORDERS (JUN 1988)" is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

This clause applies to CLINs 001, 002, 003, 004, 006, 007, 008, 010, 011, 012, 014, 015, 016, 018, 019 and 020 where fixed price delivery orders are issued by the NRC Project Officer for the Development and Presentation of the Courses.

(a) The total estimated amount of this contract (ceiling) for the products/services ordered, delivered, and accepted under this contract is (\$63,078.00). The Contracting Officer may unilaterally increase this amount as necessary for orders to be placed with the contractor during the contract period provided such orders are within and maximum ordering limitation prescribed under this contract.

(b) The amount presently obligated with respect to this contract is (\$35,539.00). The Contracting Officer may issue orders for work up to the amount presently obligated. This obligated amount may be unilaterally increased from time to time by the Contracting Officer by written modification to this contract. The obligated amount shall, at no time, exceed the contract ceiling as specified in paragraph a above. When and if the amount(s) paid and payable to the Contractor hereunder shall equal the obligated amount, the Contractor shall not be obligated to continue performance of the work unless and until the Contracting Officer shall increase the amount obligated with respect to this contract. Any work undertaken by the Contractor in excess of the obligated amount specified above is done so at the Contractor's sole risk.

2) Refer to section B.6, entitled "CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION—TASK ORDERS (AUG 1989)" is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

This clause applies to items 005, 009, 013, 017 and 021 when task orders are negotiated and issued by the Contracting Officer pursuant to G.2 - Task Order Procedures.

(a) The total estimated amount of this contract (ceiling) for the products/services ordered, delivered, and accepted under this contract is \$65,200.00. The Contracting Officer may unilaterally increase this amount as necessary for orders to be placed with the contractor during the contract period provided such orders are within any maximum ordering limitation prescribed under this contract.

(b) The Contracting Officer will obligate funds on each task order issued.

Refer to section F.3, entitled "DURATION OF CONTRACT PERIOD (MAR 1987) ALTERNATE 4 (JUN 1988)" is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

The ordering period for this contract shall commence on June 24, 2008 and will expire on June 23, 2010. Any orders issued during this period shall be completed within the time specified in the order, unless otherwise specified herein. (See 52.216-18 - Ordering.) The term of this contract may be extended at the option of the Government for an additional THREE 1-YEAR OPTIONS.

Refer to section G.1, entitled "PROJECT OFFICER AUTHORITY ALTERNATE 2 (FEBRUARY 2004)" paragraph (a) is deleted in it's entirely and replaced with the following:
