This is in reference to your letter dated May 29, 2009 providing additional information to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 29-02608-03. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. In the Report, "Final Status Survey for Johnson & Johnson Pharmaceutical Research and Development" in Enclosure 4, the Static Point Measurement results did not appear to specify the measurement units. This was the case for each static point measurement information listed for Room 011, 013/014, 015, and 016. Please specify the unit of measurement for these readings.
2. In the Report, "Final Status Survey for Johnson & Johnson Pharmaceutical Research and Development" in Enclosure 3, Table 8 did not include the information for Ludlum 2221 which appears to have been used for static measurements in each of the rooms. Please provide the information for the Ludlum 2221 in Table 8 or state that the Ludlum 2221 was not used for measurements.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office and refer to Mail Control No. 143601. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.
