I spoke with Mr. Vincenty about the pending expiration of the license. He indicated that it was the intention of the licensee to continue operations and that a check had been cut and was being prepared for mailing. I pointed out to him that the check was probably for the annual invoice that the NRC sends to each of its licensee's. A written request to renew the license which documents any changes in the program should be sent to the Region I office to start the renewal process. If the request is received after the expiration date, i.e., June 30, 2009, then the license would expire and the request would be handled as a new application. Renewals do not require any payment, however, new applications are feed. Mr. Vincenty stated that he would see that a letter was drafted requesting renewal of the license and submitted to the Region I office.
