The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) held a Category 3 public workshop on June 4, 2009, to answer stakeholder questions about the Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANPR) published on March 14, 2009 [74 FR 17115] and to obtain stakeholder input on the NRC approach in the follow-on rulemaking. The workshop was held at the Legacy Hotel and Meeting Centre, 1775 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland. The meeting was attended by twenty-four individuals primarily representing NRC staff and industry stakeholders. An additional nineteen individuals participated in the workshop through webinar or audio teleconferencing. The transcript of the meeting proceedings may be found on NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at ML091660518.

The major areas of discussion are summarized as follows:

1. Codification of NRC Orders
