Enclosed is an application (XSNM3592) recently received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), dated June 3, 2009, from Mitsui & Co. (U.S.A.), Inc., for the export of low-enriched uranium (LEU) to Japan for use as reload fuel in the Fukushima I, Units 2, 3, 4 and 5 nuclear power reactors.

Assurances from Japan that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of an agreement for cooperation are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.

Please note that the material is of Australian and Nigerien origin; converted and enriched in France, and re-converted in the U.S. It, thus, has Australian and EURATOM obligations.
