Shana:

I checked on all the items we discussed. Yes, indemnity is as we discussed. The Tech Specs are unchanged except for 5.1 and 5.2 - however, I am having that double-checked and will reconfirm Monday to your cell phone.

In regards to readiness, we will be adding the ISF Facility to procedures and requirements (QA etc.) that currently specify only FSV and TMI - that is being worked now. The records transfer to our custody under the requirements of our QA program (rather than FWENC's) should occur prior to license transfer, to be by the book. I would like to accomplish this during the period between the order and the issuance of the license amendment to be clean. The transfer operation can begin with a week's notice and should take about a week. The sooner you can give me an idea approximately when the order is to be issued, the better it is for me from a cost standpoint (early plane fares, etc).

We will also work on closing out our contract with FWENC in the interim period.
