After reviewing the above referenced inspection report, Advex Corporation concurs with the contents of the report. The report addresses the nature of the violations, root causes and the initial actions taken by Advex Corporation. Please understand, Advex Corporation regrets the subject incidents and takes the violations very serious. Advex Corporation also recognizes prevention is not a one time occurrence but is a continual process of training, control and improvement of the program.


In addition to the actions taken, as noted on the referenced inspection report, the following actions or events have taken place:

- 1- Continued training through education. Advex is developing a computer based training program, which will allow the radiation worker to receive refresher training through out the year.
- 2- Review of Operation and Emergency Procedure and are in process making needed adjustments. This action is projected to be complete by Aug 15,2009
- 3- Continued Performance Audits
- 4- Martin Ferenc, Advex Radiographer, has taken the IRRSP recertification test and passed
- 5- Lawrence R Stippich, Advex RSO, has received additional training in the Inspection and Maintenance of Equipment , given by QSA Global.
- 6- Lawrence R Stippich, Advex RSO, has received Retrieval Training , given by QSA Global.
- 7- Hold "tool box" training periodically to discuss NDT issues, including radiographic operation issues and radiation safety.

As per our conversation on 5/26/09, Advex Corporation wishes to provide information on additional actions taken. Advex Corporation further asks that it's past performance record and actions taken to resolve these matters be considered by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission during the final evaluation.
