Submittal of Information Concerning Radiological Characterization Results for the
American Centrifuge Plant**

Dear Mr. Weber:

USEC Inc. has requested lease/sublease of a number of facilities from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE). The facilities included in the request are the X-6002 boiler system; the boiler system and surrounding area in the X-3002 Process Building; the X-6002A Oil Storage Facility; and the X-2230 T2 Re-circulating Heating Water (RHW) System (piping/valves) but excluding the associated valve pits (A&B).

USEC Inc. plans to transition these areas under U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission regulation upon DOE's concurrence.

A radiological survey was performed in the areas above and indicated that all survey readings are less than the Free Release criteria stated in Section 4.8.2.4 of License Application for the ACP.
