Dear Ms. Fields:

In accordance with the Federal Activities Inventory Reform Act of 1998, and the revised Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-76 dated May 29, 2003, I have enclosed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) Year 2009 Inventory of Commercial Activities and Inherently Governmental Functions (Enclosure 1), the newly designated Commercial Reason Code A Justifications (Enclosure 2), and NRC's point of contact information (Enclosure 3). We have also submitted this information via the OMB web-based database application, the Workforce Inventories Tracking System.

Our 2009 inventory reflects a total of 285 full-time equivalents (FTE) performing commercial activities and 3,603 FTE performing inherently governmental activities. Based on our comprehensive examination of the duties associated with these positions, we are confident that this submission provides an accurate inventory of both commercial and inherently governmental functions currently performed by NRC employees.

After we receive clearance from OMB, we will post our Year 2009 Inventory on our external website and make it available to Congress.
