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SUBJECT

Control Nos. 317989 (MJC) and 318015 (BMSC)– Re – Notification (by letter dated November 6, 2008) of Change in Ownership (September 26, 2008) from Mead Johnson & Company (MJC) to Bristol Myers Squibb Company (BMSC), of that portion of licensed facilities and activity located at Highway 62 East, Mt. Vernon, Indiana, under NRC License No. 13-00772-02, issued to MJC. BMSC was the parent company of MJC both before and after September 26, 2008 change of ownership and also was the operator of the Mt. Vernon facility and licensed activity at that location, both before and after September 26, 2008 change of ownership. Further, regarding a request to divide the current license into two separate licenses, one to remain issued to MJC for the Evansville, IN, facility (gauging devices) and a new one to be issued to BMSC for the Mt. Vernon, IN facility (lab testing with prepackaged in vitro kits). Also, regarding the February 9, 2009, transaction whereby MJC "became its own company" with 15 percent of its shares being offered on the New York Stock Exchange and with BMSC controlling the remaining 85 percent. Also, regarding MJC's license amendment application, dated February 20, 2009, for License No. 13-00772-02, requesting deletion from subject license of all references to Iodine-125 and its use at the Mt. Vernon, Indiana facility, **concurrent with** BMSC's application, dated February 20, 2009, for a new license, License No. 13-32738-01, to authorize the Iodine-125 and its use at the Mt. Vernon, Indiana facility.

SUMMARY

In a telephone conversation with Ms. Boehr on this date, the following item was discussed:

I noted that a copy of the document responding to the six item request for information in NUREG-1556, Vol. 15, Appendix F, regarding the request to Transfer Control of Materials License for Iodine-125 from Mead Johnson & Company to Bristol Myers Squibb Company and signed by a management representative of both entities was appropriately attached to and a part of the new license application for Bristol Myers Squibb Company but a copy was not attached to the license amendment request by Mead Johnson & Company, but should have been. I requested that a copy of the subject jointly signed document also be provided as a part of the license amendment request by Mead Johnson & Company.
